## Report of the 2022 Committee on Elections

Houston, Texas

## TO: NRA Annual Meeting of Members

The Bylaws of the Association designate the NRA Committee on Elections as being responsible for the conduct of the election of Directors. The Committee selected a qualified accounting firm to assist with the election. The Committee also selected a qualified document imaging firm to optically scan the ballots.

The detailed procedures to maintain control over the ballots, determine their validity, and assure accurate scanning and tabulation were approved by Committee members prior to the beginning of ballot tabulation. The procedures addressed compliance with required provisions of the NRA's Bylaws, and Committee members personally observed the processes performed to confirm that all requirements were being met.

The results of the 2022 Directors' election process are as follows:

A total of 2,562,586 ballots were mailed to eligible voting members of the Association for the election of twenty-five Directors for three-year terms ending in 2025. During the course of the 2022 election a death and resignation occurred, creating vacancies to fulfill an unexpired two-year term ending in 2024 and an unexpired one-year term ending in 2023 respectively.

A total of 83,409 ballots were cast by eligible members. A total of 81,563 ballots were valid, and 1,926 ballots were invalid for the following reasons:

A total of 1,298 ballots included write-in votes or a combination of write-in votes and votes for candidates on the printed ballot. No write-in candidate, who was not on the printed ballot, received enough votes to be elected to the Board of Directors.

In accordance with Article VIII, Section 2, of the NRA Bylaws, the Committee declares the following persons to have been elected Directors of the NRA for three-year terms ending in 2025 (unless otherwise specified), to take office from the adjournment of this meeting:

Most unfortunately, Congressman Donald E. Young passed away on March 18, 2022. At the time, the ballots had been printed and the election process had already begun. The vote count for Congressman Young would have placed him fourth overall with a total of 61,646; however, as a result of Congressman Young's death, everyone ranked below him on the list moved up one position.

The remaining candidates on the ballot, who were <u>not</u> elected, are as follows:

<sup>\*\*</sup>Elected to complete an unexpired term for one-year ending in 2023. The vacancy occurred when Todd Rathner, a Director elected in 2020 to a three-year term, resigned in 2022.

One additional Director will be elected for a one-year term by those members present and voting at this Annual Meeting of Members. Eligible voters include not only Lifetime members and Annual members with five or more consecutive years of membership who were eligible to vote in the mail elections, but <u>ALL</u> Annual members present whose fully paid membership was received by the Secretary on or before April 8, 2022, who have attained the age of 18 years, and who are citizens of the United States. <u>Candidates for election at this Annual Meeting of Members are those candidates who were nominated previously for the mail election of Directors but failed to be elected.</u>

Voting for this additional Director began Thursday at 2:00 p.m. in the Voter Verification Room and will close today at 4:00 p.m., or upon the adjournment of this Annual Meeting of Members, whichever is later. The results will be announced at this evening's event, and will also be published in the Official Journal, along with the results of the mail ballot.
